Driving Directions

From Escondido California

Travel west on Highway 78 through Ramona to Santa Ysabel. (Be sure to stop at Dudley's Bakery in Santa Ysabel for great bread. - Closed Mondays). For those who don't mind going the shortest way, (over the mountain) continue on 78 and skip to the instructions "From Scissors Crossing" paragraph.

For the least mountain terrain turn North at Dudley's onto Highway 79 to S2, then East (right) on S2 (San Felipe Road) to Scissors Crossing. Follow instructions below "From Scissors Crossing".

From Temecula California

Travel South on Highway 79 through Warner Springs, then South on highway 79 to S2 then East (right) on S2 (San Felipe Road) to Scissors Crossing. Follow instructions below "From Scissors Crossing".

From El Cajon California

Travel East on Interstate 8 to California 79, then North on 79 to California 78 and East on California 78 to Scissors Crossing. Follow instructions below "From Scissors Crossing".

From Scissors Crossing

You will see a stone monument at the intersection of S2 and highway 78. Highway S-2 (San Felipe Road) comes to a stop. Turn right onto 78 toward Julian and immediately turn left, back onto S2, southward toward Butterfield Ranch Resort located at mile marker 29. Do not go up Banner Road. Continue south on S2 past Stagecoach Trails RV resort to **Butterfield Ranch RV Resort**.



14925 Great Southern Overland Route (Same as Hwy S2).

PLEASE NOTE: The nearest gas station to the Park is approximately 30 miles away and closes in the early evening. Be sure to gas up in Ramona, Julian, or Apple Valley.
